

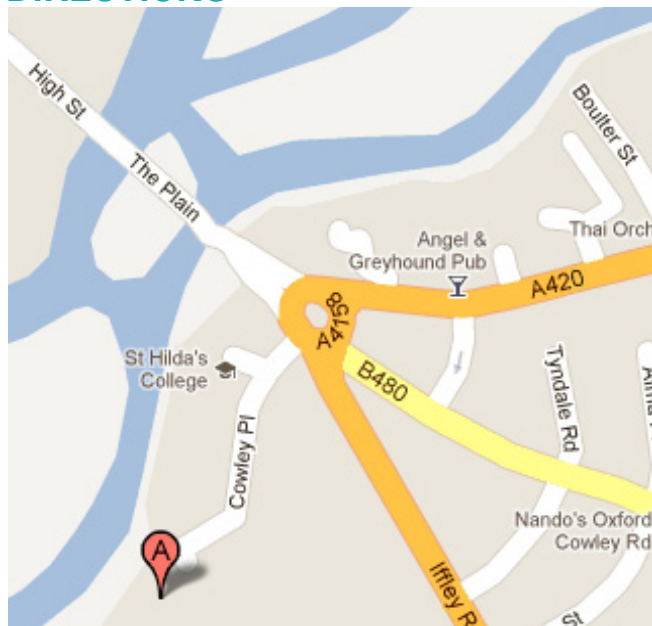


Oxford

UK-TEFL Weekend TEFL courses are held at St Hilda's College, Oxford.

St Hilda's College is set in four acres of gardens on the banks of the Cherwell on Magdalen Bridge. Located close to Oxford, you can take a punt down the river passing the Botanic Gardens, visit the historic Oxford Castle, or relax in the numerous local cafes and restaurants.

Road

From the M40 leave the motorway at junction 9 onto the A41/A34. At Wendelbury Interchange take the third exit onto the A34. Take the exit towards Cowley/Henley. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Southern Bypass Rd/A4074 heading towards the Ring Rd/A423. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Abingdon Rd/A4144. Turn right onto Weirs Lane/B4495. and then turn left onto Iffley Road/A4158. At the roundabout, take the first exit onto Cowley Place. St Hilda's College is on your right. There is a public pay and display Car Park in St Clement's, and very limited free parking in Cowley Place.

Rail

From Oxford Rail Station, St Hilda's College is around 2 miles away and is best reached by taxi, which takes approximately ten minutes. Alternatively, you can catch the 280 bus, which takes you to St Clement's Street from which St Hilda's College is a four minute walk.

Bus

There are several buses from London running around the clock, including X90, X80, X70 as well as the Oxford Tube. Buses from London take on average 1.5 to 2 hours, depending on traffic.
